Call to Order. Meeting was called to order at 1:00 PM by Chair, Liz Hendrick. Marty Brookman administered a role call to identify members on the roster.

Reading of Minutes. Motion was made by Gina Miner to waive reading of the minutes of the December meeting since they were posted in a previous NCDC Newsletter, second by Lorraine Waite. All approved. Motion passed.

Treasurer's & Membership Report. Thomas Smith reported that our bank balance is \$8,271.26 with 123 paid memberships. Welcome to new member (gift presented) Roz from Arizona.

- c. Rush Ranch Committee. Susan Hassett reported on Michael Muir's Access Adventure plans for the 2000 dedicated acres of marsh land and public lands. Per Susan, Michael wants to develop 10 of the acres to include a regulation size driving (dressage) arena (needs fundraising assistance for this) and his long term goal is to tie in driving with disabilities (Access Adventure) and to have some type of driving event once a month. His property is partially funded by Muir Land Trust. Members John Walker and Moka Davis are contributing \$2500 and want other donations to match them. - d. CDE in a Box. Jay Hubert informed us that the

organizers of the Garlic Festival CDE has offered to sell NCDC their entire CDE equipment collection for \$2,000. Includes but not limited to: letters, poles, cones, signage, clocks, radios, timers: in essence everything you would need to stage a CDE. Joe Kazza offered \$1,000 to help purchase this equipment. Many thanks to Joe. Motion was made by Laura Keister to authorize purchase of the CDE/Box, second by Shelly Chavoor. All approved.

e. The subject has come up before to have all our equipment in one place and now that we will be purchasing the CDE/Box, we need to purchase a trailer to house all our equipment. Jay proposed we purchase a 12 ft. long cargo trailer totally enclosed. Jay Hubert, Mike Dowd and Buck Scholderer will comprise the committee to research and purchase the trailer and are authorized to spend up to \$2,500. Gina Miner made motion to approve the purchase of the trailer as stated above, Sheri Lacey second. All approved. Mike Dowd and Sharon Waite offered to house the trailer until another suitable spot can be arranged.

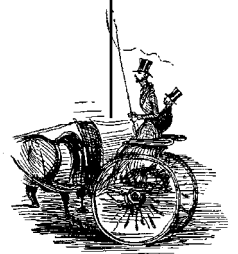

There are 9 venues offered and to be part of the Challenge a competitor must participate in at least 3 different locations. There will be an OVERALL AWARD (the equivalent of \$250.00 or more in cash and prizes) for TRAINING AND PRELIMINARY LEVELS. This award will be given at the November Meeting of the Minds/ ADS meeting in Clovis , California .There will also be Division Awards given. The divisions are: VSE - SINGLE ; MULTIPLE, PONY - SINGLE ; MULTIPLE, HORSE - SINGLE ; MULTIPLE

The awards will be based on a points system as follows:

One point is given for every event attended whether the competitor places or eliminates. The three highest scoring events will be used for the cumulative score.

This score will be one point given for every competitor beaten. As an example: if there are 5 in your class: First place will give you 4 points plus one point for attending for a total of 5 points. Second place will give you 3 points plus one point for attending for a total of 4 points. Third place will give you 2 points plus one point for attending for a total of 3 points. Fourth place will give you 1 point plus one point for attending for a total of 2 points. Fifth place will give you 1 point for attending.
